Library Collection & Support

Swilley Library has a collection of more than 11,000 nursing and health sciences print books, nearly 4,000 electronic health sciences books, and subscribes to 240 nursing and health sciences related journals in electronic or print format.

The library also provides an interlibrary loan service and interlibrary use cards for materials that are not in our collection. Mercer is a member of the Atlanta Regional Consortium for Higher Education (ARCHE). Faculty and students have access to library services at 19 Atlanta area university libraries with the interlibrary use card.

Electronic Databases & Resources

Selected Databases

- **AccessMedicine**
A full-text resource of over 50 textbooks in clinical and educational medicine. Also has drug information, practice guidelines, quick access to diagnosis and treatment of 800 disorders, diagnostic tests, customizable patient education materials, and health news channels. Image, video, and audio content are available as well. Also see GaIN: Georgia Interactive Network.
- **Alt-HealthWatch (at EBSCOhost)**
Focuses on multiple perspectives of complementary, holistic, and integrated approaches to health care and wellness. Full-text content comes from more than 160 international peer-reviewed and professional journals, magazines, reports, proceedings, and association and consumer newsletters, plus hundreds of pamphlets, booklets, special reports, original research, and book excerpts.
- **CINAHL: Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature**
Search 800 nursing and allied health journals, nursing dissertations, and selected other biomedical journals. Many full-text articles are available. Limited coverage of psychology and management literature is also included.
- **Cochrane Library**
Search for evidence-based information on the effects of health care interventions. Includes fulltext of reviews in the Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews. ****NOT AVAILABLE OFF CAMPUS.**
- **Dynamed**
Medical information database for Point-of-Care reference.
- **ERIC: Education Resource Information Center (at EBSCOhost)**
Covers all aspects of education and educational research, includes both abstracts of published and unpublished sources on thousands of educational topics.
- **Facts and Comparisons (Efacts)**
Drug information monographs on U.S. prescription and OTC drugs grouped by therapeutic category for ease of comparing products. Also includes orphan and investigational drugs. Note: For non-commercial academic use only.
- **GAIN: Georgia Interactive Network**
Health care information network offering a wide range of information services. Resources include full-text books and journals, e.g. AccessMedicine, MD Consult, Stat!Ref, Pier, images, and multimedia, evidence-based medicine, several other links and databases.
- **GALILEO: Georgia Library Learning Online**
An initiative of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia. A web-based virtual library, GALILEO provides access to multiple information resources, including secured access to licensed products. Participating institutions may access over 100 databases indexing thousands of

periodicals and scholarly journals. Over 2000 journal titles are provided in full-text. Other resources include encyclopedias, business directories, and government publications.

- **Health Source: Nursing / Academic Edition**

Provides nearly 520 scholarly full-text journals focusing on nursing, allied health fields, and many medical disciplines as well as abstracts and indexing for over 550 journals.

Also included is the USP Pharmacopoeia DI: Volume II Advice for the Lay Patient and Stedman's Medical Dictionary.

- **MD Consult**

Searchable clinical resource available through GaIN. Includes full-text journal articles and online textbooks. Also see GaIN.

- **MEDLINE**

Provides access to National Library of Medicine's database, as well as links to some full-text articles.

- **MicroMedex** (*PDA version available*)

Full-text monographs on natural medicines, herbal medicines, and dietary supplements. Search by ingredient or product name. Note: For non-commercial academic use only. Also, Micromedex is not to be accessed while in an off-campus medical facility (e.g., on rotation).

- **OVID Medline**

Search the Medline and OldMedline databases of almost 5,000 medical journals, with links to full-text articles for 260+ journals.

- **PubMed** (*PDA version available*)

NLM search engine for Medline and OldMedline databases. This customized portal will identify references for fulltext that is available for free on the Internet and via the Swilley Library. Searchable from your PDA.

- **STAT!REF**

Access to full-text searchable textbooks, including a medical dictionary, MedCalc 3000--an evidence-based medical reference and tool set, with formulae, clinical criteria sets and decision tree analysis tools, and other links.

- **Web of Science / ISI Web of Knowledge**

Provides information in the sciences, social sciences, and arts and humanities found in international journals, open access resources, books, patents, proceedings, and Web sites.

- **Wilson Omnifile**

A multi-disciplinary database providing indexing, abstracts, and full text - from six of Wilson's databases: Education Full Text General Science Full Text Humanities Full Text Readers' Guide Full Text Social Sciences Full Text Wilson Business Full Text. Abstracts and indexing from five additional periodical databases are included; when available, full-text articles are also included: Applied Science & Technology Full Text, Art Full Text, Biological & Agricultural Index, Index to Legal Periodicals & Books, Library Literature & Information Science Full Text.
